Activities

Syllabus

Beginner level: Course geared towards students who have not studied Portuguese before. Aims to offer the basis to develop their linguistic knowledge through spoken language in informal and semi-formal contexts.

According to student's proficiency **Basic level:** Emphasis on everyday interaction, based on activities aimed at practicing the language spoken in the informal and semi-formal contexts. Writing of small texts. Focus on aspects of Brazilian culture.

Intermediate level: Emphasis on everyday interaction, based on activities aimed at practicing the language spoken in the informal, semi-formal and formal contexts. Production of textual genres of everyday life and academic life. Focus on aspects of Brazilian culture.

Cultural topics: Brazilian people and society (environment, urban space, family, work, university and leisure).

Communicative functions: introductions, greetings, questions, requests, accepting and denying requests, inviting, thanking, buying, asking for information, apologising, locating oneself, showing appreciation and dissatisfaction, desires and needs. Intermediate level also includes argue and counter-argue.
